Emergency Notification Procedures

To contact the Police Department, call 911. Call from a safe location and remember:

Stay calm

Be prepared with answers to the following questions:

Where is the emergency?

What is the emergency?

How did it happen?

When did it happen?

What is your name?

Quickly gather as much information as you can. Give a phone number of a safe location where you can be contacted by emergency responders.

Do not hang up until instructed to do so by the dispatcher.

General Information for Emergency Situations

Fire Extinguishers

Fire extinguishers are located in all sections of the school and in the repair room. First Aid Kits

First aid kits are located near the men's restroom, in the stocks section and in the design and function section.

Eye Wash Stations

Eye wash stations are located in the stocks section and near the bluing area. <u>AED</u> Located next to the eyewash station near bluing area.

Evacuation Procedures

A building occupant is required by law to evacuate the building when the fire alarm sounds. There may be instances where the building would be evacuated without the fire alarm sounding.

When evacuating your area:

Stay calm, do not rush or panic.

Safely stop your work.

Gather your personal belongings if it is safe to do so. Remember your prescription medications if possible; it may be hours before you are allowed back in the building.

Proceed to assembly areas discussed in section orientation and report to your instructor to take roll. Instructors please have attendance sheets available.

Do not re-enter the building until you have been instructed to do so.

Notify your instructor of the location of any injured persons still in the building so emergency responders will be made aware.
